Tax Forms 1098 & 1099: Watch for your 1098 and 1099 tax forms, they will be sent out by the end of January to those receiving one. Please retain for your tax records.

IRA Owners: Fair Market Value (FMV) and Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) notices will also be mailed by the end of January.

Helpful Fraud Tips: When you receive a call or text message from SHAZAM, respond quickly to SHAZAM when they reach out to you about your recent transactions. SHAZAM's short code for sending text messages is 72718 and SHAZAM fraud services telephone number is 855-219-5399. You should only respond to texts or calls from those numbers. If you need to call SHAZAM to report a lost or stlen card, call 800-383-8000.


