PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY

EVERY TWO SECONDS AT LEAST ONE PERSON'S IDENTITY HAS BEEN STOLEN. WHY NOT TAKE THE PROPER ACTION TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THIS HAPPENING. HERE ARE A FEW QUICK TIPS:

- Use strong passwords/pins & make sure to keep them secret
- Completely log out after accessing financial accounts
- Do NOT respond to emails that are requesting personal information
- Secure your confidential documents
- Avoid using public computers and be prudent when using public Wi-Fi access

PRACTICE THE 3 D'S

- DETER identity thieves by safeguarding your information
- DETECT suspicious activity by routinely checking your financial accounts
- DEFEND against ID theft as soon as you suspect a problem

When Should I Reveal My Social Security Number?

In general, you will need to provide your SSN to:

- Employers for wage and tax reporting purposes
- Financial institutions for tax reporting purposes
- Landlords or utility providers, such as a power company, for a credit check
- Government agencies to obtain services and to file your taxes
- Credit reporting agencies Equifax, Experian or TransUnion – or AnnualCreditReport.com to obtain your credit report or credit score

When you are asked for your SSN, make sure to ask the questions below to help you decide if you can reveal it or not.

- Why do you need my SSN?
- Will you accept a different form of identification?
- How will you use my SSN?
- How do you protect my SSN & other information from being stolen?
- What will happen if I don't provide my SSN?
